SAN ANTONIO VA COMMUNITY LIVING CENTER RESIDENTS BEING TRANSFERRED TO KERRVILLE VA MEDICAL CENTER

(SAN ANTONIO) – The Audie L. Murphy Memorial Veterans Hospital (ALMMVH) is transferring twenty-one residents from its Community Living Center (CLC) to the Kerrville VA Medical Center. The transfer is expected to take place beginning Wednesday, July 1.

‘The transfer will allow for expanded acute care bed capacity at the Audie L. Murphy VA,’ said Medical Center Director/CEO, Christopher Sandles. ‘With the increase of COVID cases in San Antonio, Audie Murphy’s inpatient COVID census has increased from 44 a week ago to its current census of 48. ‘

At this time, residents will remain at the Kerrville Campus through September. VA is notifying family members this week to inform them of the transfers. A temporary ‘no visitor’ policy still remains in effect at Kerrville; however, VA can facilitate virtual visits so that family members may be able to visit with their loved ones at their convenience.
